

About the project

Rigshospitalet – Glostrup has been granted 29 million DKK from the Danish ministry of Health pool to strengthen the hospital-based initiative for youths with acquired brain damage. The target-group are youths between 15 and 30 years old, who live in the Capital Region of Denmark and hit by a brain damage.

Strengthened initiative for youths with acquired brain damage is a 4 year project that should put new initiative started with the purpose of:

To track youths, who have an acquired brain damage to follow youths close and qualify the health professionals, who meet the young patients.

Neurological Clinic and Clinic for High Specialised Neuro rehabilitation/Traumatic Brain damage in the Rigshospital cooperates about project Strengthened initiative for youths with acquired brain damage.

Basis and purpose

In 2011, the Danish Health Authority prepared a course program for rehabilitation of children, youths and adults with acquired brain damage. Project Strengthened initiative for youths with acquired brain damage must contribute to implementing the parts of recommendations of the course program, which relates to hospital-based detection, elucidation and rehabilitation. The project should also develop and test tools, which ensure better coordination of initiatives in the hospitals in the Capital Region of Denmark and in cooperation with municipalities and general praxis.

The project should have particular focus on improving the initiative to the youths, who today fall outside the systems or are not offered the elucidation and rehabilitation, which makes them able to live an independent and meaningful life. In addition, the project must strengthen the effort of the youths' relatives.
