

## About monitoring UIP track 2

According to the political agreement about the Development and Investment Program (UIP), there has happened a monitoring of the method distribution in the program. It has been decided that the monitoring design in UIP is mainly focused on the application of national registry data. The strength of the chosen design is that register data makes it possible to follow the citizens development on relevant outcome indicators<sup>1</sup> over several years. In addition, registry data is both nationwide and at the same time associated with a small reporting burden on municipalities, as citizens development is monitored via registry data from Statistics of Denmark.

### **reporting requirements**

It will be mandatory for the municipalities to report CPR numbers to the citizens, who receive an effort based on the method, which the municipality has received implementation support for. The CPR number should allow data to be linked to the national records. In addition, a few supplementary cases will also be required. The latter mentioned information will be included in the analyses as well as contribute to the interpretation of the results.

BOX 1: reporting requirements

CPR number, start month of effort, information target group / social issues, citizens' functional level at start, referral basis (SEL §).

### **About the monitoring**

The data collection will take place twice a year, based on reporting template and guides that the National Board of Social Services will prepare and send to the municipalities. Since this is primarily collecting CPR-numbers and case information, it should be possible for most municipalities to extract this information from municipalities professional systems and paste into the reporting template. Data will be sent and received via secure mail. With secure mail, data will be encrypted and protected, while it is sent between the municipalities and the National Board of Social Services. After that the actual data processing will take place in the Ministry system of the Ministry of Social Affairs at Statistics of Denmark. Data will be pseudonymised so the personal data cannot be attributed to specific people. Likewise, the analyses will only be produced in aggregated and anonymized form.
