Get free dyslexia lessons

We test and teach anyone, who have difficulties with achieving the reading and writing requirements that are set.

You may have:

- difficulties with reading new words
- difficulties with spelling
- are unsure when to write

Danish for people with dyslexia

Tuition in Danish for people with dyslexia

In cooperation with your teacher, you identify what must be worked on in the education. In this way, the teaching is tailored to your needs and desires.

For example, you may be taught:

- Reading: You will be helped to become a more secure and fast reader
- Spelling: You get strategies to spell better
- Grammar: You get help with Danish grammar depending on the level
- Writing: You get strategies to write better

Offer of IT tools

You get access to IT tools that can read aloud to you or help you spell. E,g, CD ORD and IntoWords. There are programs for computers, tablets and smartphones. Together with your teacher you identify which programs and tools that can help you the best.

English for people with Dyslexia

Education in English for people with dyslexia

There is taught:

- Pronunciation
- Vocabulary
- Spelling
- Grammar and sentence structure

Together with your teacher you find out, which goals you will work towards.

You get taught with the material "HELP". The material is specifically developed to people with dyslexia and systematically trains the difficult English speech sounds and spelling patterns. The material includes a home-based program that you can install on your own computer.

Danish for people with dyslexia, e-learning

Danish for people with dyslexia as e-learning is for you that:

- Needs the flexibility due to job or family life
- You have time to work or study on the side
- You decide when you read and do tasks
- You can improve your skills and move on in life with further education or new job-field

You do not have a set schedule or hours to abide by, but rather an individual delivery plan. The teacher follows your learning closely. The teacher also continuously follows up on your delivery plan together with you.

Facts about people with dyslexia in Denmark

Are you unintelligent then?

To be dyslexic does not have anything to do with your intelligence – or whether you are good at knowing the difference of right and left.

Is it inheritable?

If you have dyslexia, there often are other people in your family, who have had problems with learning to read and write.

How many people with dyslexia are there in Denmark?

7% of adult Danes answered in a survey from 1991 that they perceived themselves as dyslexic.

What does it mean in the school?

Dyslexia is a learning disability that makes it difficult to learn to read and write.

Mathematics disorder

If you have a test on the fact that you have mathematics disorder, you can get extended time for tests and exams, where your mathematics disorder gives you challenges. It can for example be math, chemistry or similar.

If you want to be tested for mathematics disorder, you should contact the municipality that you reside in.

The supervisors in our dyslexia guidance can help with where you can be screened (tested for mathematics disorder).

Economy, when the municipality covers

If you are under 18 or on cash assistance, your municipality should pay for you. You can find out the price by contacting our study administration.

Additionally, you can borrow books by CPH SOUTH and seek SU, if you are over 18 years old.

We offer expert guidance within the field of dyslexia. Contact us, then we can tailor a course with you according to your needs. For example, for:

- Primary schools that have received refugees
- Other actors, who are connected to the municipality
- Under 18 and over 18 years-old
